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Covenant Corner: Weed and Yard Cleanup Alert!

It's that time of year when weeds are growing, and in some instances, they have become quite a nuisance. Weeds, along with yard clutter and neglect, diminish the beauty of our beloved Foxridge community. We encourage you to take a moment and step back to assess your yard's appearance from the street. Is there something that can be done to enhance its overall look?

If you find yourself unable to perform yard work personally, there is a convenient solution available. Every month, in the Teen Services listing of Foxtales publication, you can find a comprehensive list of neighborhood teens who offer their services. They are willing and able to assist you with your yard maintenance needs.

We understand that financial constraints may be a concern for some residents. If that is the case, please don't hesitate to contact us at foxridge.board@gmail.com. We are here to help and can work together to develop a plan that accommodates your situation.

It's worth noting that even if weeds are located in easement areas, such as between the city sidewalk and GID fencing, it remains the responsibility of the homeowner to maintain that specific area up to the edge of the sidewalk. It's important to remember that just because it may be out of your direct view doesn't mean it's out of public view. Further information regarding these responsibilities can be found in the covenants. If you're unsure about your specific filing, you can easily visit our website at foxridgecommunity.com and click on 'About Us'. There, you will find answers to this and other questions you might have.

By working together and taking proactive steps to enhance the appearance of our yards, we contribute to the overall beauty and appeal of Foxridge. Let's make our community a place we can all be proud of.

From Denver Water: *Outdoor Watering Rules are in effect May 1 to Oct. 1.*

These times are based on a sprinkler system running at an efficient level. Watering is not allowed between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. This chart is a starting point for the number of minutes to water each sprinkler zone on the days you determine watering is needed. These times are averages. Adjust your watering minutes based on rainfall, type of grass or plants, sunny or shady locations and other characteristics. Watering two days a week should be sufficient during most of the summer. If needed, water a third day only during extreme heat or dry periods. Water trees and shrubs as needed, but not between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. Shrubs and perennials need half as much water as lawns. There are no assigned watering days, but never water a zone more than three days per week.

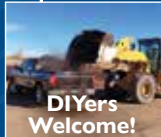

Letter From The FIA President

Watering and mowing yards: This one is easy...water your yard and mow it. If you are physically unable, call one of the kids listed in the back of this newsletter or the team that FoxRidge uses, Ike & Isaac at 303-680-7016.

Vandalism: Every neighborhood, even gated communities have this issue. Rule one: get motion lights outside of your home. Rule two: keep an eye out for your neighbor's home as well as yours. Rule three: report any issues to the police.

Dog Poop: Pick it up, especially if you are in the park or greenbelts. Scratch that: pick it up anywhere in FoxRidge.

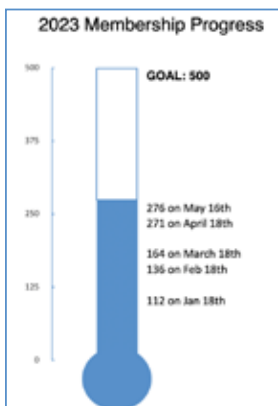
This issue of Foxtales came to your physical mailbox via the US Postal Service. The articles about Foxridge are composed by Foxridge Improvement Association Board members, Foxridge residents and community agencies. It is formatted, printed, and mailed to the 934 homes in Foxridge by Porchlink Media.

Back in the early 1980's, it was a grassroots effort. People who had information to share gave them, on a slip of paper, to Ann Niebes. She typed up the garage sale notices, recipes, block party invitations, and offers of services. Norm Zettel took it to the printer at Dry Creek and Quebec for 100 copies to be made. Kathy Rice, Joan Zimmer, Ruth Cain, and others collated and stapled them to be delivered door-to-door by "block workers," such as Gaye Vazquez.

Today, previous issues of Foxtales are archived online on the Foxridge website. We would love to find issues of the earlier Foxtales. If you are a long-time resident who might have an issue stashed away, please take a moment to try and find it to share with us. We'd like to hear your stories and see any other memorabilia from the early Foxridge days. We might share it in future Foxtales articles.

News from the Foxridge Community Garden (FCG)

The steering committee of the FCG is excited for the gardening season! Much is planned in the garden from social events, Kid's Club events to a variety of initiatives for many to get involved in and enjoy.

The FCG is planning to plant a pumpkin patch with a variety of pumpkins. Carving pumpkins, cooking pumpkins and decorative pumpkins will be grown at the top of the hill next to the raised bed/sand area. Help will be needed to water and guide the pumpkin vines down the grassy slope as they grow.

The new location for the sunflowers will be along the south fence that borders the path and St. Thomas More School. Assistance will be needed to water and support the sunflowers as they mature. The fence may be key in this process.

The large garden pots in the middle of the first row of raised beds will be dedicated to herbs. Sage, thyme, mint and dill are among the herbs that are growing from last year. It'll be fun to see what else will thrive in those big pots.

There will also be a few community or shared garden beds planted this year. Many different veggies will be grown to share with our FCG volunteers and donated to local food banks as well. These shared beds contain garlic, potatoes, tomatoes, different varieties of squash and tomatoes and so much more.

The FCG Kid's Club will be hosting events each month of the gardening season. The first event scheduled for May 20th will be a planting party. The theme for the Kid's Garden this summer is PIZZA! Yum!! A list of Kid's Club events and dates can be found below.

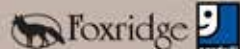

Natural Neighbors: Cliff Swallow

They're back! Under the Dry Creek bridge leading to Homestead open space, you'll find cliff swallows.

- Cliff swallows nest in colonies, each pair making its gourd-shaped nest from specks of mud (the center nests are the most desirable).
- Expert flyers, they catch insects in the air. One bird may lead the others to an insect swarm.
- Young birds leave the nest and congregate in groups called creches. Parents find their young by the sound of their voice.
- They generally spend 3 months in North America, 3 months migrating south, 3 months in South America and 3 months migrating north.

Message from Patrick Fleming, City of Centennial GID Manager:

The Foxridge GID recently selected Martha Riley as the contractor for project manager services in 2023. Ms. Riley is a longtime Foxridge resident who is very involved with neighborhood improvement. As GID representative for the past several years, she has been worked with City staff and contractors to improve and maintain landscaping and fencing in the community. She will continue to do so and will work closely with the new GID representative, as well. The project manager services for the GID include helping to determine projects, soliciting estimates and bids from contractors, and overseeing their work. The services are also expected to be utilized in the upcoming Trex materials replacement. The funds for the contract were approved by the FGID Board of Directors as part of the 2023-2024 budget process.

GID Fence Repairs:

Details should be coming out soon about the specific plans for fence work and repairs should begin soon after that.

Martha has been in touch with Cody Cocas (Split Rail Fence Co.-SRF) to begin working on the fence repair project.

Weekly meetings with Martha, Patrick Fleming and me will be held as phasing continues.

City Launches Free Mobile App

The City of Centennial has launched "My Centennial," a free mobile app providing residents another option to submit service requests and report problems to the City.

Citizens may download the My Centennial app through iOS or Google Play to their mobile device and report potholes that need filling, traffic signal issues, graffiti and more. This mobile app includes an option to snap and submit a photo of the issue or request with your device and will automatically find the location using GPS, if the setting allows.

Users of My Centennial have the option to create an account and track the status of their request or submit anonymously. Additionally, My Centennial allows citizens to:

- View service requests at any time
- View requests made near their location
- Comment on open requests
- Respond to comments made on requests

In addition to the mobile app, service requests may continue to be submitted via the "Report a Problem" button on the City website (centennialco.gov/reportaproblem) or by calling the 24/7 Citizen Response Center at 303-325-8000.

Napa Cabbage Slaw

Submitted by Kathy Irwin

- 8 cups (about 1 lb) coarsely shredded napa cabbage (usually about 1 head of napa)

Add your choices of veggies (any or all):

- 1 1/3 cup shredded carrots
- 1 1/3 cup thinly sliced radishes
- 1 1/3 cup thinly sliced green onions
- 1 1/3 cup slivered snow peas
- 1 1/3 cup cilantro leaves
- 2/3 cup slivered almonds

In a large bowl, combine cabbage and veggies. Refrigerate until ready to serve. At serving time, add creamy soy dressing. Mix gently to coat.

Creamy Soy Dressing

- 3 T red wine vinegar
- 3 T sugar
- 1 T soy sauce
- 1 garlic clove, peeled and minced
- 1/2 tsp Asian sesame oil
- 1/2 tsp ground ginger
- 1/4 tsp cayenne
- 1 cup mayonnaise

In a small bowl, combine all ingredients except mayonnaise. Stir until well blended and sugar has dissolved. Gradually whisk in the mayonnaise, stirring until well blended.

Yield: 14 cups – 14 servings

Note: You can substitute lettuce for the napa cabbage. (I usually make the dressing and keep it on hand to use on rotisserie chicken or seared ahi tuna. You can make main dish salads or Asian inspired tacos – be creative!)
